Special Needs Accommodation Process



The Special Needs Accommodation Process Team is a multidisciplinary group of representatives from the Exceptional Family Member Program, Child, Youth and School Services and Army Public Health Nursing working on behalf of Families to determine the safest, least-restrictive and most appropriate placement for children/youth with special needs.

Special Needs Accommodation Process is a Child, Youth and School Services registration requirement for all children with special needs.

A special need is a medical, developmental or behavioral condition identified and validated by a healthcare provider.

It is initiated upon verified sponsorship eligibility and through

completion of a health screening tool during registration at CYSS Parent Central Services.

CYSS is not an entitlement; it is a service. Every attempt is made to include children into programs that best meet their needs.

Every child will receive a recommended care plan based on the information presented.
