JBLM Child & Youth Services is pleased to announce that hourly care service will not be curtailed at our installation. Beginning in May, limited hourly care spaces will be available from 0830-1630 at Clarkmoor and McChord CDCs. May reservations will be taken beginning noon Monday, April 17 via WebTrac at JBLMcysRegistration.com. The hourly care mission is to provide short-term, intermittent care for things such as medical appointments, Armed Forces Community Service training, FRG meetings and job interviews, and we understand the hardships a complete closure would have caused our Families. (Please note, hourly care at school-age centers is not affected.)

This revised hourly care plan still allows us to meet the needs of full-day care for Air Force, Army, Marines, Navy, activated Guard and Reserves and Coast Guard. Please accept our heartfelt apologies for any inconvenience experienced.

While ensuring active duty Service members can work full-time is still our primary focus, we remain hopeful we can re-open hourly care to its full operational capability in the near future.
