
- 1. OVER-THE-COUNTER FIREWOOD IS FOR PERSONAL USE ONLY AND CANNOT BE RESOLD. Commercial firewood dealers may call (253) 964-2100 for information on sealed-bid deck sales.
- 2. Joint Base Lewis-McChord fuelwood is primarily decked logging debris. <u>Cut from marked decks only.</u> <u>UNMARKED</u> blown down trees/single logs/miscellaneous fuelwood away from the decks must remain on the ground for habitat. No standing trees, alive or dead, may be cut.
- 3. Only <u>one (1) cord per day</u> can be cut. Trucks/trailers exceeding one-cord capacity <u>cannot be filled</u> <u>beyond the one-cord limit</u>.
- 4. Only empty vehicles are permitted in the cutting area. All wood found in a vehicle is assumed to be taken under the current permit.

^{**}Cleanup areas are where only scraps (small pieces and/or large chunks, butt ends, etc.) and/or lower-quality material remain from full-price areas.

- 6. Permits are effective for two (2) days: the day of purchase and/or the following day.
- 7. Saturday permits are sold on Friday. No cutting is permitted on Sundays or holidays.
- 8. Permit Sale Hours: Walk-in hours are Monday through Friday, 7:30 am to 10:00 am, or until permits are sold out, whichever comes first. After 10:00 am, please call (253) 964-2100 to set up an appointment.
- 9. Cutting and hauling are generally authorized between dawn and dusk or as noted on the permit.
- 10. Special circumstances, such as fire ban levels and firewood availability, can result in temporary changes to the above-mentioned policies.
- 11. Because firewood availability can change quickly, firewood cutters are strongly encouraged to call the prerecorded information line or the office for the most current information before coming in for a permit.
- 12. Although permits are issued to all members of the public, this office <u>does not sponsor</u> non-military or non-government individuals onto Joint Base Lewis-McChord. Please contact the Visitor's Center at (253) 966-8139 for current entry procedures and requirements for getting a day pass to cut firewood.
