



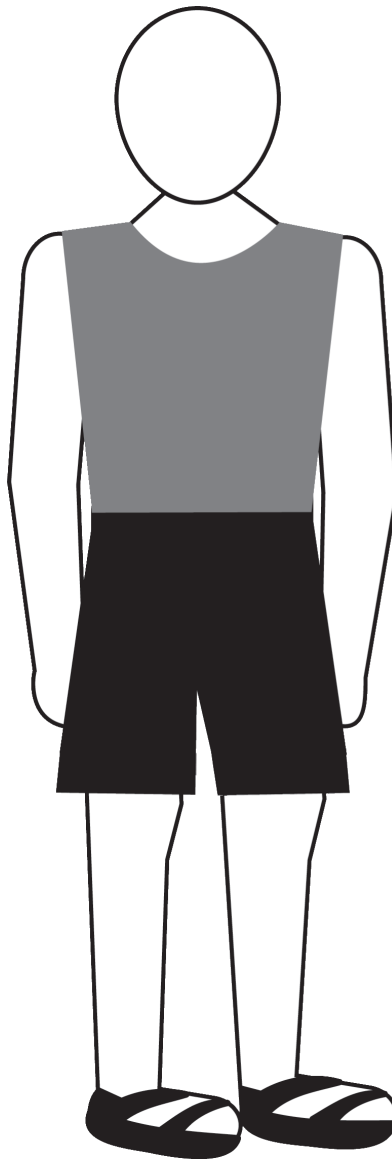

Youth Dress Code

In order to facilitate learning for all youth, CYS Services requires that youth appearance follow health and safety standards and not cause disruption to the learning environment. Youth who do not follow these guidelines will be asked to change their clothing, cover up, or go home if necessary.

Other Guidelines

- Clothing that promotes drugs, alcohol, tobacco, violence, is sexually suggestive, or displays inappropriate pictures or writing is prohibited.
- Any clothing worn in a manner identified as gang-related is prohibited.
- Jewelry that can pose safety hazards is prohibited.
- Exceptions to dress code standards may be made for sporting and water activities.
- Hoods must be down at all times.
- Pants must be at waist.



Torso: Clothing must cover stomachs, backs, shoulders, chests and undergarments.

Legs: Shorts must have at least a 3 inch inseam. Skirts and dresses must not exceed 3 inches above knee.

Feet: Footwear must be worn at all times appropriate to the activity. Strapless shoes and heels are discouraged for safety reasons.
