



Hunter Registration

Individuals who wish to hunt on Joint Base Lewis-McChord must register with the Northwest Adventure Center. Registration for hunting begins July 1 of each year; register seven days a week from 9 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Civilians may also register at the Northwest Adventure Center, but they must first obtain a visitor's pass from the Visitor's Center.

In order to register, each person must provide the following:

- Driver's license
- Valid hunting license
- Proof of car insurance and vehicle registration for the vehicle you will be hunting with
- The make, model, serial number, barrel length and overall length of each firearm you plan to bring onto the installation. The information will enable you to complete the backside of the hunter registration card with only those guns you will be using for hunting on the installation.
- After you register, you will then use the telephone call system to sign into an authorized training area. All hunters will view JBLMmwr.com online under Outdoor Recreation ▶ Hunting ▶ Range Training Area for area access availability.
